## Scappoose High School Community Service Guidelines

### Community Service Creed

*"Community Service is the rent you pay to live in your community"*

Community Service at Scappoose High School is defined as service that is done which serves more than one person and benefits the community as a whole.

Community Service hours that can be accepted may consist of the following:

- Service done with school sanctioned clubs
- Service done with outside clubs such as Kiwanis, 4-H, etc
- Service done through a church organization
- Service done for individuals other than relatives such as at a nursing home, animal shelter, etc.
